*Years of planning, prayer and inspiration* have led to a vision which is outlined in our new campus Master Plan. This plan includes updating, rehabbing and repurposing our 100 year old campus facilities for ministry consistent with our mission today. Our hope is to collaborate with other nonprofits, service providers and government agencies on our campus to meet the life needs of children, youth, and families in the Española Valley.

The Master Plan consists of four primary buildings broken four phases:

- **Phase 1 Cole Adult Ministries Center**
- **Phase 2 Hovermale Children's Ministries Center**
- **Phase 3 Bachman Retreat Center**
- **Phase 4 McCracken Teen Center**

Playgrounds, landscaping, walking trails, a prayer garden, solar installations, parking and a community garden will complete the campus redevelopment.

## Bachman Hall becomes the Retreat Center

The Retreat Center will truly become the heart of the McCurdy Ministries Community Center and will house up to 65 persons including volunteer teams and other retreat program participants from across the country. The Retreat Center will also be available for class and family reunions, weddings and celebrations. The building will be expanded to the north and west to create space for a much needed dining room and industrial kitchen. Our preschoolers and volunteers will enjoy their meals in the dining hall. The new kitchen will allow us to cater the breakfast and lunch programs for other preschools and charter schools in the area. Other building improvements include a new metal roof, building envelope, HVAC and windows to improve energy efficiency, new bathrooms and ADA compliance.

## Hovermale Elementary becomes Children's Ministry Center

The Children's Ministry Center will be a welcoming place filled with energy, imagination and learning. The programs and services offered in the building will be:

- **Two four year old Pre-K classes**
- **Camp Stars, our summer camp, combines the best of STEM education and Vacation Bible School.**
- **After School Care with four classes for preschool to older elementary children.**
- **Computer lab**
- **Teaching kitchen for developing life skills**

The Children's Ministries Center will be renovated to improve energy efficiency, provide safe playgrounds, improve ADA compliance and create an inviting, comfortable space.

## McCracken Gym becomes McCracken Teen Center

McCurdy Ministries' dedication to children and youth has inspired the concept of a Teen Center where youth can participate in all types of activities to have fun, build confidence, increase educational skills and develop the social skills needed for life success.

We will partner with local nonprofits that specialize in youth programming to expand youth programming in our community, and invite a local drama/dance program to use this facility for their programs. Energy efficiency and handicap accessibility improvements are the highest priority in this building. A combination of donations, grants and community support to improve this building are essential.

## Our Master Plan creates welcoming space for transforming lives



The McCurdy Ministries Community Center Board and staff have been diligent in our efforts to chart an inspiring vision for our future. The planning process has been rooted in prayer and motivated by our century old commitment to share the love of God through education and service. While we have a strong history of transformational ministry in the Española Valley, the need is great. In our area 29% of the population lives under the poverty line, the per capita income is \$19,430, and 22% of those under the age of 25 have not graduated from high school nor earned a High School Equivalency. Sixty-percent of the chil-

dren we serve are being raised by grandparents. This is our mission field. God has put McCurdy Ministries here to help children, youth and families in the Española Valley and show the love of Christ to our community. For many of our children, God's love is experienced through a nourishing lunch, a quieting word from our counselors, attention and care from a volunteer tutor and a fun and safe place to be after school. God entrusts us with the privilege to show God's love to the people we serve. Our staff and many volunteers serve our community with helping hands and loving hearts.
