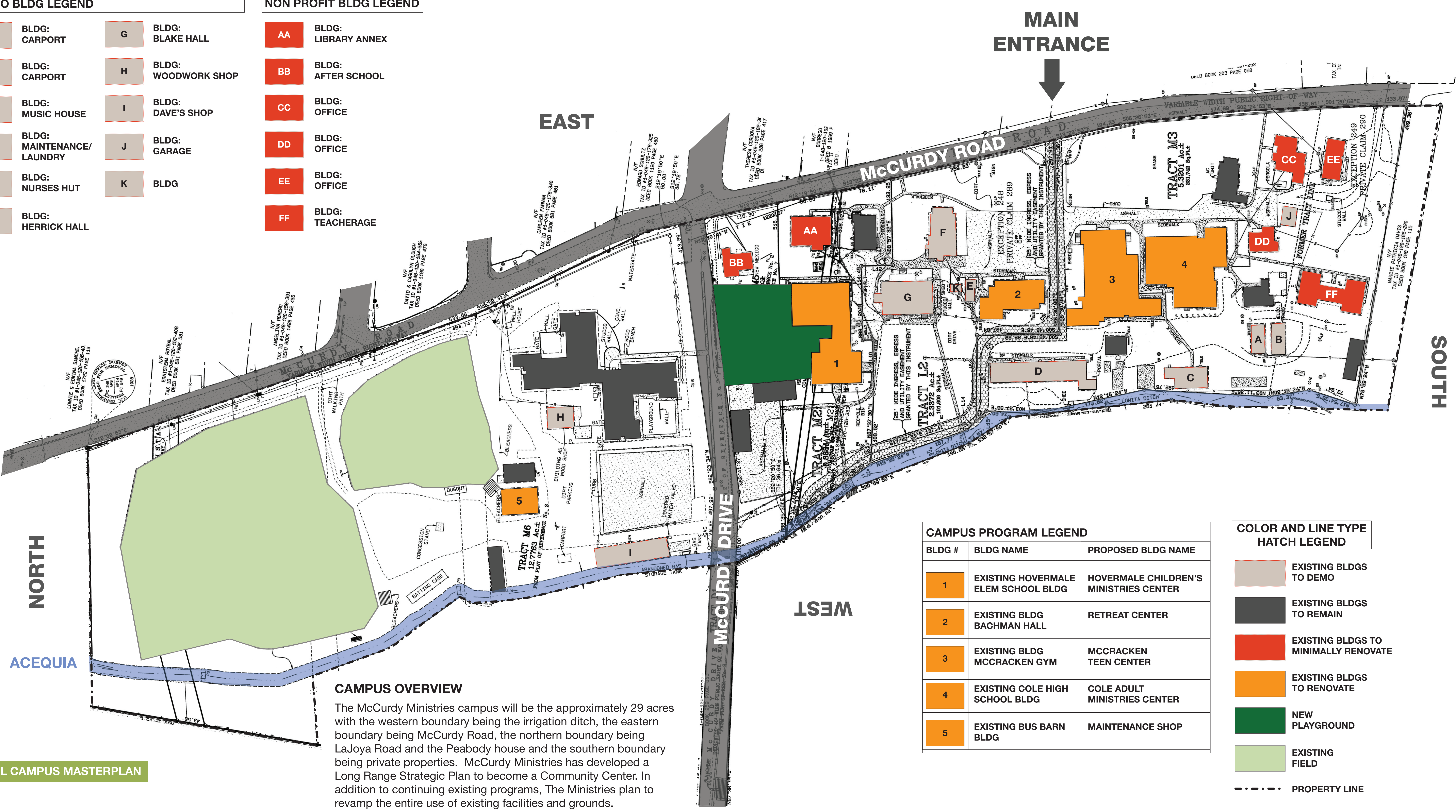

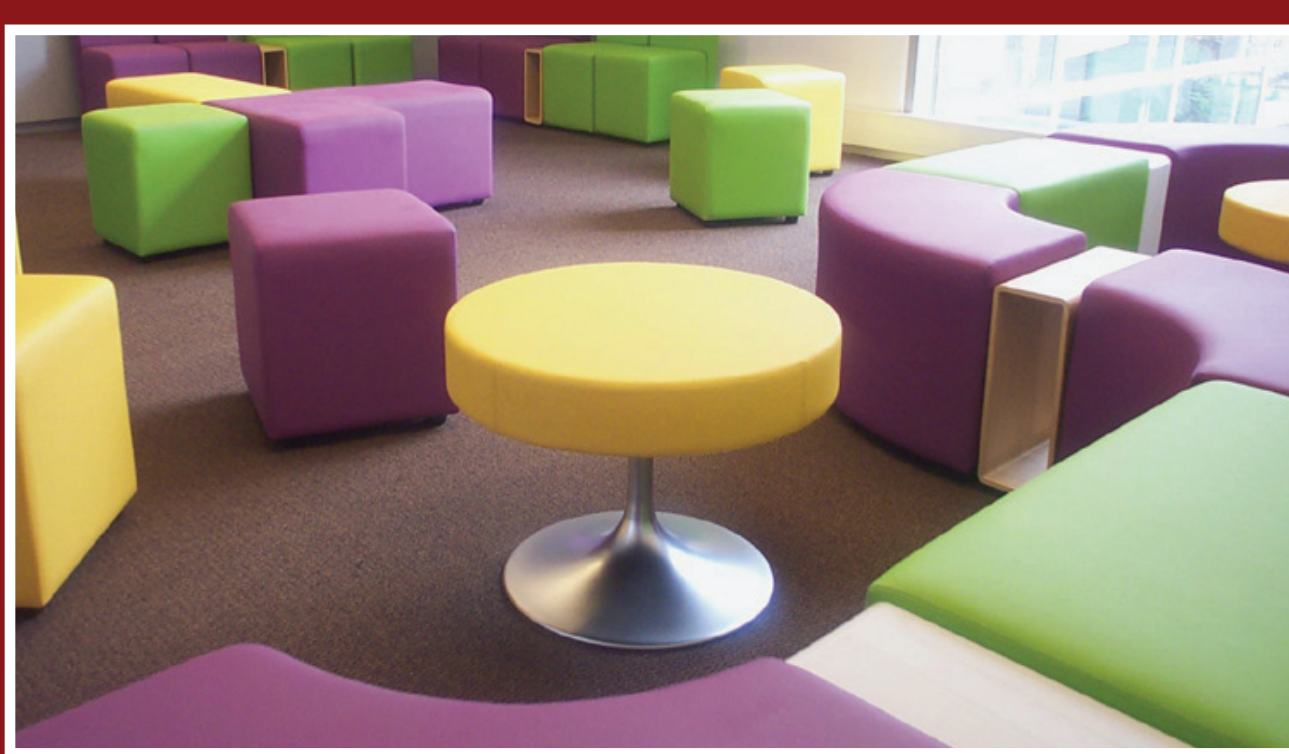

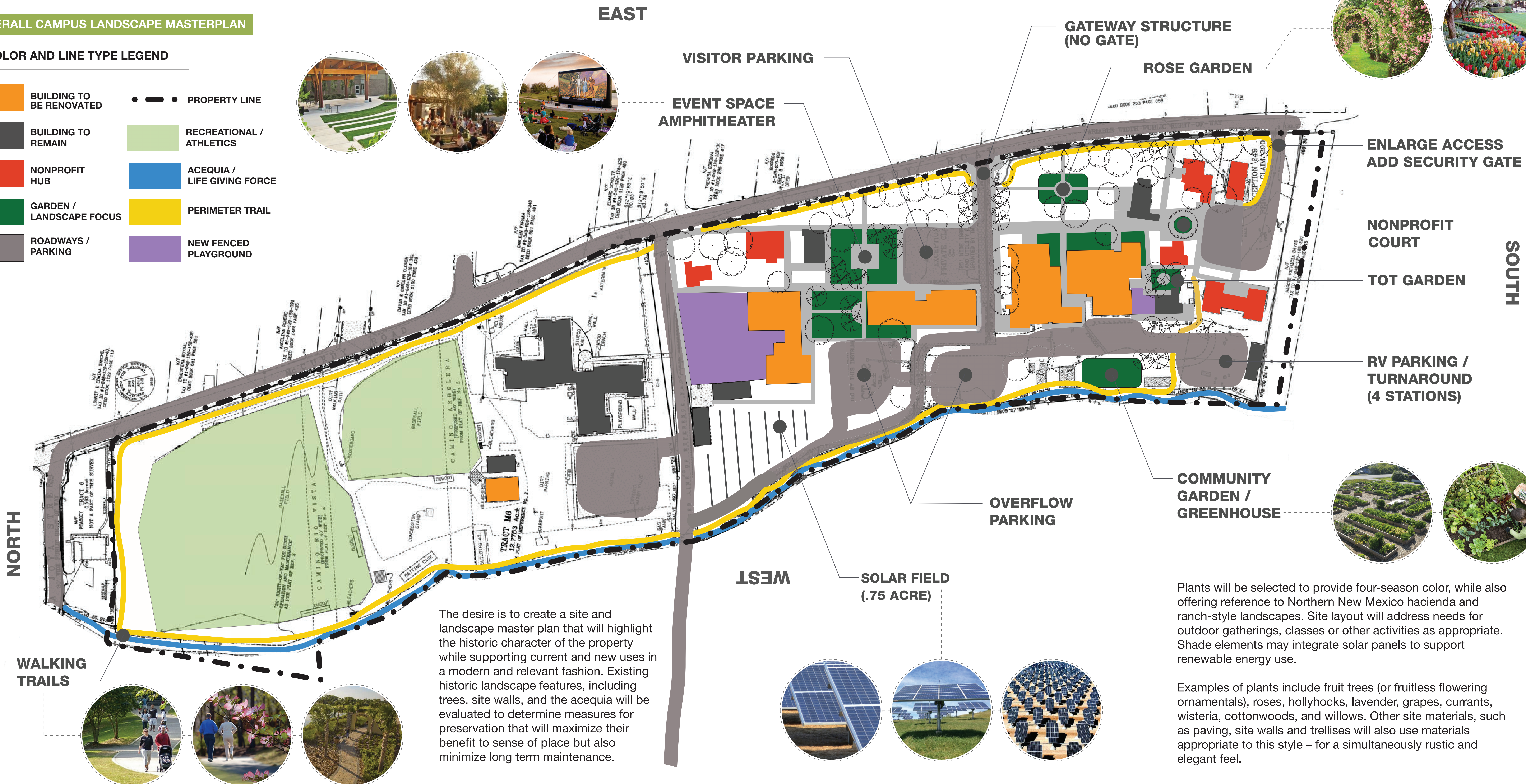

Plants will be selected to provide four-season color, while also offering reference to Northern New Mexico hacienda and ranch-style landscapes. Site layout will address needs for outdoor gatherings, classes or other activities as appropriate. Shade elements may integrate solar panels to support renewable energy use.

Examples of plants include fruit trees (or fruitless flowering ornamentals), roses, hollyhocks, lavender, grapes, currants, wisteria, cottonwoods, and willows. Other site materials, such as paving, site walls and trellises will also use materials appropriate to this style – for a simultaneously rustic and elegant feel.
